Have passed the Higher Secondary School Examination (10+2) system or an equivalent examination there to securing in the aggregate not less than 50% of the total marks (45% in case of candidates belonging to reserved categories) be less than 20 years of age on First July 2010.

However in case of reserved category candidates the maximum age limit shall be 22 as on the above date.

B. Intake and Reservations: - The selection shall strictly be on the basis of merit as determined by the Common Law Admission Test 2010 subject to the Reservations as per Bihar (In Admission in Educational Institutions) Reservation Act 2003 (Bihar Act 16 of 2003) besides other rules. They are as follows:-

Total no of Seats : 80(Eighty only)

1. Scheduled Castes : 16%
2. Scheduled Tribes : 1%
3. Extremely Backward Classes (Annexure - I) : 18%
4. Backward Classes (Annex. - II): 12%
5. Women of Backward Classes : 3%
6. Person with Disabilities : 3%
7. 30% of the total seats shall be filled by eligible women candidates including those selected in reserved categories.

NOTE:- Unfilled seats, if any, in Foreign Nationals and NRI's / NRI sponsored category will be filled in as per the Bihar Act No. 16 of 2003.

POST-GRADUATE PROGRAMME ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for admission to the 2-year full time LL.M. Degree Programme, a candidate should have passed the LL.B./B.L. Degree or an equivalent degree from a recognized University not less than 55% marks in the aggregate (50% in case of SC/ST/OBC)

INTAKE AND RESERVATION

The intake for the course will be a maximum of SIXTY and minimum of FORTY with the following reservations

Category	Percentage
(a) Scheduled Caste	16%
(b) Scheduled Tribe	01%
(c) Extremely Backward class (Annexure-I)	18%
(d) Backward classes (Annexure-II)	12%
(e) Women of Backward classes	03%
(f) Persons with Disabilities	03%

Direct Admissions:- Out of a maximum of 60 seats for LL.M. Course 10 seats will be allotted to Foreign Nationals and 10 seats will be allotted to NRI's/NRI sponsored candidates. These categories of candidates are exempted from taking the Common Law Admission Test. However they shall fulfill other requirements regarding age and qualifications as per CLAT-2010 and CNLU eligibility Regulations.

Note : Unfilled seats if any, in foreign nationals and NRI/NRI sponsored category will be filled in as per the Bihar Act No. 16 of 2003.

SPECIALISATIONS OFFERED

Each candidate must choose an area of specialization from the following:

- Intellectual Property
- Corporate Law and Governance (Including International Business)
- Constitutional Law and Administrative Law
- International Legal Order.

NOTE: A subject specialization will be offered subject to availability of faculty and sufficient number of students.
